What: Mandatory Christmas Service Project. The scouts will put on Christmas parties for the residents of Audelia Manor, Brookshire Apartments, Glen Oaks Apartments, and the New Room.

When: Saturday, December 12th, 2009

Time: Morning Shift 9:00 am – 11:15 am; Afternoon Shift 2:00 pm – 5:00pm (see patrol assignments below).

Where: LHUMC and in the LH community

Why: To provide service to LHUMC and the community it serves as a “Thank You” for being our chartering organization.

Attire: All scouts are to wear Class A uniforms for this project.

Details:

STUFF TO BRING

ALL SCOUTS AND VENTURES* ARE TO BRING THE FOLLOWING TO LHUMC FELLOWSHIP HALL BY 9 AM ON DEC. 12TH.

- a) A **minimum** of one dozen homemade cookies per scout (or homemade looking).
- b) 10 pieces of fruit per scout as assigned by patrol:
 - Red Apples: Alligator, Dragon, Sharks, Eagle
 - Green Apples: Ram, Piranha, Phoenix
 - Pears: Lynx, Bulls, Gecko
 - Oranges: Penguin, Wolverine, Mustangs, Coyote, Hawk
 - Tangerines: Python, Bat, any Venture not in a patrol
- c) \$12 per scout (cash or check payable to Troop 890)

Morning Shift: 9 am – 11:15 am (All first & second year scouts*) Report to the Great Hall (gym) and sit down by patrols as you would for a troop meeting. You will be assigned duties of assembling gift bags for the residents and signing Christmas cards. (* and leader scouts who have been assigned).

Afternoon Shift: 2 pm – 5pm (All other scouts) Report to the Great Hall (gym) for the afternoon shift. You will deliver gift bags to Audelia Manor residents, and host a Christmas party for them OR you will be assigned to host Christmas parties for one of the other locations.

PARENTS NEEDED:

- a) We need **6 parent volunteers** for the morning shift to help prepare bags and cookie platters for the parties.
- b) We need **15 parent volunteers** for the afternoon shift to transport the scouts and gift bags/supplies to apartments and bring them back to LHUMC when the parties are over.
