2011 Summer Camp Scheduling Guidelines

Course Offerings: Courses are offered in the morning at 9:00 AM, 10:00 AM, and 11:00 AM. Following lunch, courses are offered at 2:00 PM and 3:00 PM. Some courses are 1 hour in duration; others are 2 hours in duration, and a few last all day (5 hours).

Open Times: It is not necessary to schedule Open Times. Open times are scheduled at 4:00 PM every day, giving Scouts the flexibility to go to any of the Areas, work on merit badges that may need extra time, participate in Troop activities, or just have FUN.

Course Selection: Scouts should select the courses they need for rank advancement and courses that are interesting and fun. However, they should pay attention to recommended rank and any BSA age restrictions. Each scout will need the approval of his first year scout master at sign up night on Monday, May 16, 2011

Block Out Times: Some Scouts may want to block out specific times in the morning and the 2 hours in the afternoon. They should select as their 1st choice the **Free Time** course offerings. This will reduce their choices of courses.
